## Notes regarding Request for Preliminary Funding Release:

- cannot be used for UBC O Internal funding
- cannot be used for student projects
- full approval must be obtained within the time frame stated in the award letter
- preliminary funds cannot be used for sub-grants for tricouncil funds; subgrants can only be processed once full ethics approval is obtained. As per tri-council guidelines "You must obtain any required certificates (e.g., involvement of human subjects, animals, etc.) within six months of the award date. The institution will not release the funds to you during this period. The award will be cancelled if the certificate requirements are not met within six months."
- Maximum amount of request: up to 40% of year one funds
- funds cannot be used for research work that involves human participants
- to limit the liability to the faculty/department/unit, if the sponsor will not release the funds until full ethics approval is obtained, then preliminary release of funds will not be approved
